July 11, 2010-- Clallam County Citizens for Safe Drinking Water sent a press release to the Peninsula Daily News on June 21 indicating that the group was re-activating because of specific safety concerns that the group has. Although Reporter Mike Carman indicated that he would include these concerns, they were omitted from the notice in the paper.

Mike Carman, in an email to Keith Wollen on July 3, 2010, indicated:

"I will put in an item that your group has reformed for the reasons you have listed. I am going to have to shorten and cut some of the content and write it in our style. I will also put the date of your next meeting which Veronica has provided."
